



# Pupil Premium Funding

## Information for BNO Families

### What is Pupil Premium Funding?

Pupil Premium funding is a government grant allocated to schools to support and further develop the educational outcomes of eligible pupils. It is often called Free School Meal Funding as this is one of the benefits that an eligible child would receive.

### Do you hold a British National Overseas Passport?

If you hold a British National Overseas Passport, you may be eligible to receive Free School Meal funding for your child. The criteria for eligibility involves the following thresholds.

The annual household income thresholds for those families able to work is below:

- £22,700 for families outside of London with 1 child
- £26,300 for families outside of London with 2 or more children

In addition to these thresholds, families must hold no more than £16,000 in capital and savings.



### How will this benefit my child?

- Additional support to enhance learning and wellbeing
- Free school meals will continue through KS2 (years 3-6)
- Financial contributions to help with trip costs and clubs
- Free milk provided daily
- Support with preloved uniform
- Food vouchers during school holidays and free places in holiday clubs

### How to Apply:

If you meet the eligibility criteria and would like to apply to receive Free School Meal funding for you child, then please visit one of our admin centres and our office team will be able to support you with your application. You will need to complete a simple form and provide evidence of your BNO passport along with evidence of your current income.
