<b>Year 1</b>	<p>Writing:</p> <p>Write your own list poem about the winter starting with Winter is... and then writing a list of things about winter e.g.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">frozen puddles Shimmering cobwebs Freezing wind</p> <p>Maths</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Go on a shape hunt around the house – what shapes can you find?</li> <li>• Practise your number bonds.</li> </ul> <p>Science</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Research what animals live in cold areas and how they have adapted to the cold climate</li> </ul> <p>Phonics and reading</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Continue to read books at home</li> <li>• <a href="#">Revise phase 3 sounds on phonics play</a></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Draw or make a shelter for an animal. Children could use any resources around the house or outside.</li> <li>• Numbots</li> <li>• <a href="#">Have a go at this Joe Wicks workout!</a></li> </ul>

Remember that it doesn't have to rhyme. You might like to use this repeated first line at the start of each stanza e.g. <i>In the winter...</i></li> </ul> <p>Reading:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Snuggle up somewhere warm and read a good book – maybe your school library book, your school reading book or your own book from home.</li> <li>Draw a picture of one of the characters and write words around them to show how they are feeling.</li> </ul> <p>Maths:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Numbots</li> <li>Times Table Rockstars</li> </ul>
