New Home Learning Approach

We are delighted to introduce a new approach to home learning, developed in response to your valuable feedback and our ongoing commitment to ensuring children master the essential 'nuts and bolts' of their learning. This initiative will focus on the key knowledge and skills that form the foundation for success in each year group.

As part of this approach, children in Year 1 will be provided with CGP books to borrow: one for maths and one for comprehension. These books are for reference and guidance only and should not be written in. Instead, children will be given a dedicated home learning exercise book in which to complete their work.

Home learning books will be handed out at the start of term. Children will be asked to complete the tasks over a two-week period and bring their books into school to share with their teacher every fortnight. The work will include:

- A maths task
- A reading comprehension task

A chart showing the specific pages to complete can be found at the front of your child's home learning book.

In addition, children should continue to read daily and use Numbots regularly to support fluency in maths. Home learning will be celebrated in class, and we encourage children to review and mark their work with an adult, using the answers in the CGP books.
