New Home Learning Approach

We are pleased to introduce a new approach to home learning, developed in response to valuable parent feedback and our continued commitment to ensuring children master the 'nuts and bolts' of their learning. This initiative will focus on the key knowledge and skills that form the foundation of success in each year.

As part of this approach, children in Year 5 will be provided with three CGP books to borrow: one for maths, one for grammar and one for comprehension. These books are to be used for **reference and guidance only** and should not be written in. Instead, pupils will complete their work in a home learning exercise book, which they will be given.

Home learning will be set on Mondays, and children will have one week to complete the tasks set. The work will include:

- A maths activity
- A grammar, punctuation and spelling activity or a comprehension activity
- A Spelling Shed assignment online

A chart detailing the specific pages to complete will be shared with each home learning cycle.

Children should continue to read daily and use TT Rock Stars to help support their fluency in times tables. Home learning will be celebrated in class and pupils are encouraged to mark their own home learning with an adult using the answers in the CGP books.
