








**This term's Doorways...**



**Doorways and Pathways**

'Behind Enemy Lines'. The children will be learning about how propaganda was used during World War 2, and recreating their own, enlarged propaganda posters using scaling. We will also be finding out about rationing during the war, as well as how people had to 'make do and mend', considering how the day to day lives of people in Britain were affected. We then look forward to sharing all our knowledge and learning with families during our FAB finale event

**This term's Values...**



**Maths**

This term we will begin by securing our knowledge of place value before applying this to addition, subtraction, multiplication and division calculations and problem solving. Fractions will be a big focus this term. We will work on addition, subtraction, finding equivalents and multiplication and division of fractions before finishing the term converting between units of measure. We will have regular calculation and independent practice to enable the children to apply knowledge learnt and revisit it regularly.

**English**

In English this term, we will focus our narrative work around the book *Rose Blanche*, set in WW2. Children will focus on development of plot, character and use of dialogue. We move to a non-fiction unit where children will write a letter to Mr Scrooge before ending the year looking at 'The Sky Falls' by Phil Earle, a story of hurt and kindness also set in WW2. Alongside side this, daily spelling and grammar lessons will further develop the children's ability to structure their writing well.
