

Doorways and Pathways

'The Great Galapagos'. The children we will be learning about Charles Darwin's journey to the Galapagos islands, under the heading of 'The Great Galapagos'. Our learning journey will give us the opportunity to develop our geographical knowledge and study the physical features of the islands, the significance of longitude and latitude and the climate of the tropics.

This term's Values...



Maths

This term we are continuing to learn about fractions, finding out how to add, subtract, multiply and divide with them. We will also be working with decimals and percentages in more detail, linking this work to our knowledge of fractions. We will then go on to develop our knowledge of algebra by using simple formulae, using algebra to solve missing number problems and using the 'nth' term for sequences. We will also focus on the written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

English

We will begin the term looking at poetry, specifically riddles. In writing and grammar, we will be developing our understanding and skill in recognising and using a wider range of punctuation, including: brackets, dashes, hyphens, semi-colons and colons. Children will write a balanced argument piece where they use a range of techniques such as conjunctions for opposition, emotive language and rhetorical questions. Children will also respond to the text 'Kensuke's Kingdom' in a number of ways.
