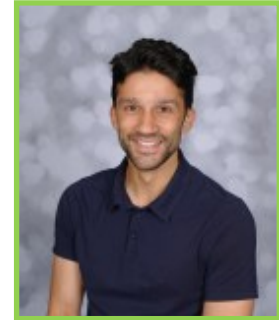

Doorways...

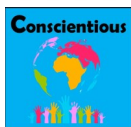


Doorways and Pathways

Maths

This term, children will complete units on algebra, ratio, shape, position and direction and then revise areas within maths for children to feel secure in all areas. Then we will be consolidating everything we have learnt in our time at Oxley Park to help continue to build on their mathematical confidence ahead of secondary school.

Following this, we will be exploring how we can use maths in different contexts including science and DT.

English

In English this term, we will be completing short burst writing pieces giving children the opportunity to showcase all writing and grammatical features they have learnt. Children will be exploring creative writing to reflect upon their journey at primary and the journey ahead when moving to secondary. In grammar, we will be consolidating all we have learnt through primary school including our understanding and skill in recognising and using a wider range of punctuation as well various clause structures.

Science

This half term, we will continue to study 'Electricity'. We will be associating the brightness of a lamp with the number and voltage of cells used in the circuit. We will compare and give reasons for variations in how components function, including the loudness of buzzers and the on/off position of switches. With this understanding we will use recognised symbols to representing a simple circuit in a diagram.
